Allowable Reasons for a Bond

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... designing, constructing, renovating, improving, upgrading, updating, acquiring, and equipping school facilities (and any necessary or related removal of existing facilities), the purchase of the necessary sites for school facilities, and the purchase of new school buses, refinancing an existing note ...

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Bond will be used for:

- Construction Overage - \$400,000
- Playground and Cover - \$ 65,000
- Weight room Remodel for all PE classes - \$ 40,000
- Paying off of 2 Buses - \$ 90,000
- Activity Van-14 Passenger \$ 60,000
- SECO Loan Payoff - \$ 95,000



Cost to the Homeowner

How will funds be used

Bond funds will be used to FINISH the construction project. Currently, fund balance money will be used for construction overage. If passed, Bond funds will be used for construction overage while fund balance will be utilized to purchase other needed items.

Ballot Language

PROPOSITION A

THE ISSUANCE OF \$656,000 OF BONDS BY THE BELLEVUE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF. **THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.**

PROPOSITION B

THE ISSUANCE OF \$ 94,000 OF BELLEVUE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT REFUNDING BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING ALL OR A PORTION OF THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON THE DISTRICT'S STATE ENERGY CONSERVATION OFFICE LOAN AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF. **THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.**
